The Rec. Dept. is now taking registrations for any Farmington area students in grades 7 and 8 who want to take part in our Spring Tennis program. The deadline for registering is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 2nd.

Participants will meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30 - 4:00 at the Hippach Field Tennis Courts, beginning Tuesday, May 6th and continuing until Thursday, May 22nd. Players will learn and practice basic strokes, as well as gain understanding of the rules and scoring associated with the game. Through a variety of fundamental drills, students will be taught the proper method for hitting forehands, backhand and serves. As the players progress, each will play practice sets against others of similar ability. Participants must supply their own rackets and water bottles.

Please note: This program is limited to the first 8 to register.

This year's program director will be Amanda Quirion. Amanda graduated from Skowhegan Area High School and played on the high school's varsity tennis team for three years and was the First Singles player for her Junior and Senior years. This last school year she has worked for the Rec. Dept. as a supervisor for after school hours and Pickleball and is excited to share what she has learned about the sport she loves.
