

Town of Farmington Road Postings – Heavy Loads Limited

Pursuant to 29S M.R.S.A. Sect. 2395 and provisions of local traffic ordinances. Road postings shall remain in force except when the way is solidly frozen. The highway is considered solidly frozen only when the air temperature is 32 degrees F. or below and no water is showing in the cracks in the road. Both conditions must be met. Orange Road Posters will be displayed on posted roads as deemed necessary.

Exemptions:

- *Emergency Vehicles defined in 29-A MRSA sect. 2054
- *Public Utilities
- *Municipal Vehicles
- *School Buses
- *Wreckers towing disabled vehicles
- *Home Heating Fuel (Oil or Propane) Delivery Trucks
- *Bulk Milk / Bulk Feed trucks with MDOT Exemption Certificate
- *Any vehicle or combination of vehicles registered for a gross weight of 23,000 lbs and traveling without a load, other than tools or equipment necessary for the proper operation of the vehicle.
