K-9 Officer Axle joined the Farmington Police Department and was assigned to his handler, then Officer Michael Lyman in 2016. Officer Lyman would later become a Sergeant for the Department. Officer Axle was trained in Drug Detection through the Maine Criminal Justice Academy graduating in August of 2016. During his time at the Farmington Police Department Officer Axle's work included:

- 118 total sniffs.
- 153 random/free air searches with no suspicion.
- 145 bail conditions, search warrant and probation checks.
- 120 articulable suspicions related to investigations.
- 126 positive indications.
- Approximately 22% of sniffs concluded in a positive indication.
