The Town of Farmington is accepting applications for a part-time Laborer at the Recycling/Bulky Waste Transfer Station. This 20-hour per week position involves manual labor and requires the ability to use tools and equipment including backhoe, brooms, shovel, and an assortment of hand tools properly and safely. The starting wage is \$12.00 per hour. Desired qualifications include graduation from a high school or GED equivalent, ability to effectively meet and deal with the public and the ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing. Class B Commercial Driver's License is desirable as well.
