The Town of Farmington is currently seeking applications for the full-time position of Foreman in the Public Works Department. Duties include operating heavy and light equipment, plowing and sanding roads in the winter, and manual labor. The employee in this position performs a variety of unskilled, semi-skilled, and skilled tasks in a variety of weather conditions and must possess the stamina to work long hours. Night, weekend, and holiday work may be required. Highly recommended to have a valid State of Maine Class B Commercial Driver's License with a good driving record and mandatory pre-employment drug screening required. This is a working foreman position that oversees and works with a group of skilled and semi-skilled workers and equipment operators engaged in Public Works activities. The successful candidate will be required to maintain highways, plow sand, pave, and reconstruct town roads within Farmington.
