TOWN OF FARMINGTON (Owner) is requesting Bids for the construction of the above referenced Project. Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the **Town Office** located at **153 Farmington Falls Road, Farmington, ME 04938**, until **April 16, 2026 at 1:00 PM** local time. At that time the Bids received will be **publicly** opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work:

Milling and paving of a portion of Main Street with associated curb and sidewalk construction. Installation of a new segmental block retaining wall, drainage, lighting, reconstruction of Hippach Field parking area and access road, and construction of a new brick wall at Hippach Field. Project also includes installation of new water service and metering at Hippach Field.

Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

Bidding Documents may be purchased from the Issuing Office during the hours indicated above. Cost does not include shipping charges. Shipping costs will be \$10 per set of bidding documents mailed. Bidding Documents are available for purchase in the following formats:

Bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5% of the Total Bid Price as outlined in the Instructions to Bidders. Payment and Performance Bonds will need to be provided at Contract Signing as described in the Contract Documents. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids. No bidder may withdraw his bid within 60 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

This Contract is expected to be funded in part by the **Maine DOT Municipal Partnership Initiative**. This Contract contains requirements from this funding agency. Neither the Maine DOT, nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees, is or will be a party to this contract. The word "agency" in the contract documents refers to this funding agency. Award of any Contract will be contingent upon final financial agreements between the Town and the funding agency. The project scope may be adjusted to match available funding.
